WHAT SHPOS COULD ACCOMPLISH WITH A \$50 MILLION APPROPRIATION

- Expedited review
 - Marketing of credit through education and outreach
 - Private sector training through workshops
 - Increased consultation with developers
 - More site visits and advice to owners and developers
- Restoration of historic places important to local citizens
 - Economic stimulus for community revitalization
 - Increased job creation using skilled workers
- Expedite reviews
 - More site visits and hands-on assistance to agencies and applicants
 - Conduct needed training for agencies and applicants
- Increase number of CLGs by 33% – to total of 1,850 CLGs
 - \$7 million in pass-through grants from SHPOs to local communities, doubles current level
- Assist local governments with Preserve America program
 - Promote the initiative
- 10% increase in National Register listings
 - Re-initiate historic resource identification projects
 - Assist applicants in researching and completing nominations
 - Accelerate digitization of historic site information to benefit researchers and project planners
- Publish documentation on historic sites
- Augment assistance to localities in utilizing their historic resources as heritage tourism assets
