### WEATHER

Weather in Tulsa in October is generally warm, but not excessively hot. Average temperatures range from lows in the low 50s to highs in the mid 70s with an average rainfall of 4 inches.

### ABOUT TULSA

With a population of over 400,000 people, Tulsa has been described as “a blend of the best of urban and rural America.” More than 50 major companies exist just blocks away from bungalow-lined streets. Warm weather allows residents and visitors to enjoy hundreds of parks and nearby lakes and gardens. Tulsa is one of the smallest cities in the country to support professional, full-time ballet and opera companies, and a symphony orchestra, and is home to two world-class art museums: the Philbrook Museum of Art and the Gilcrease Museum.

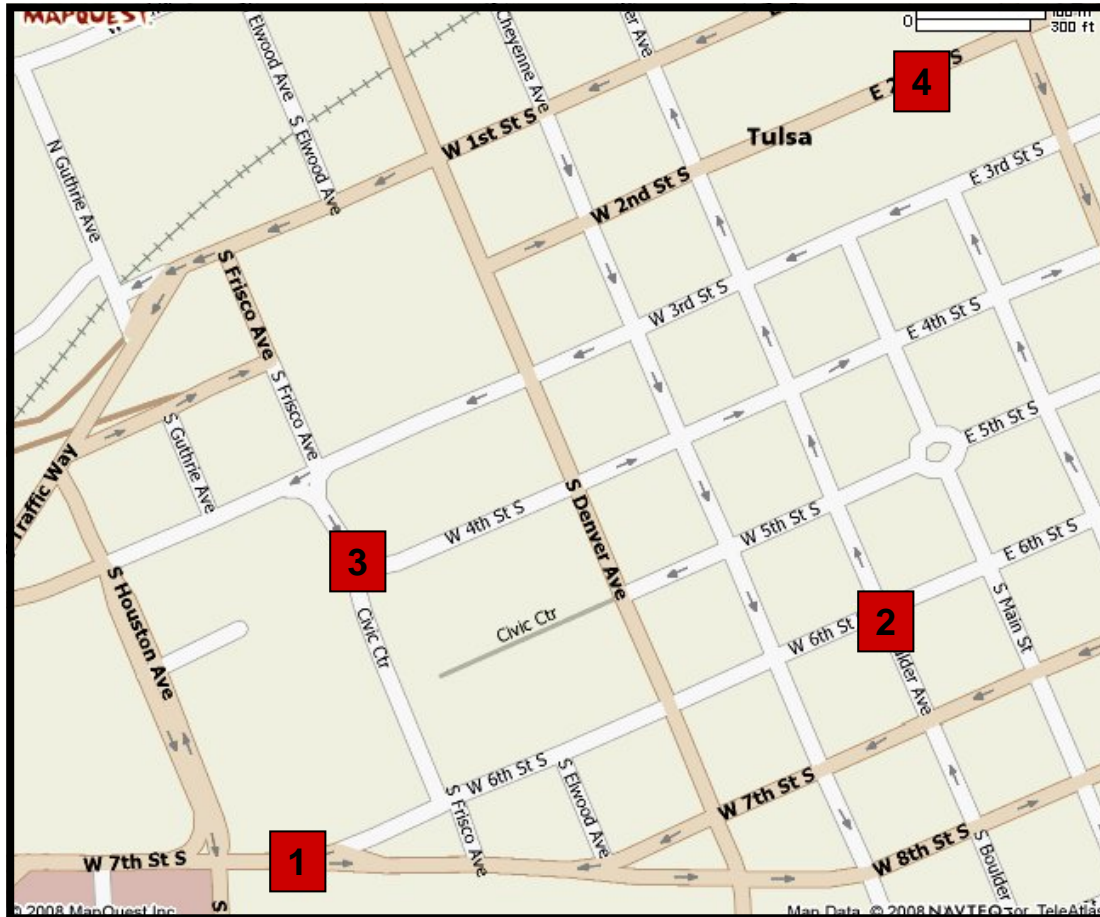
